After three outstanding editions that brought together more than 150 boys and girls from all continents, Water Polo Club Radnički proudly presents the next chapter of the Summer Water Polo Camp.

For 2026, the camp moves to **Trebinje**, offering participants an even richer overall experience while maintaining the same professional standards, methodology, and coaching excellence. The camp will be held in two sessions, from **August 2nd to August 11th** and **August 12th to August 21st**, welcoming boys and girls of all ages, as well as coaches.

VCamp participants will have the unique opportunity to learn from renowned water polo experts, including camp coordinator **Dragan Kozmora**, as well as one of the greatest players of all time, **Andrija Prlainović**, who will serve as a demonstrator in both camp shifts. Olympic champions from Paris 2024 and European champions from Belgrade 2026, **Uroš Stevanović**, head coach of the Serbian national team and Radnički, and **Miloš Ostojić**, goalkeeper coach of the national team, will help create the camp's training plan and program.

TRAINING PLAN

During the Summer Water Polo Camp, which will last 10 days per shift, there will be 2 training sessions per day in the pool lasting 2 hours, as well as one dry training session, lasting 1 hour.



TWO LEVELS OF TRAINING

For those who completed the first level of training, we will be organizing the next stage of development. However, if necessary, we will also reinforce and review the fundamentals covered in the first camp to ensure every player progresses at their own pace.



Additionally, all new camp participants will undergo an initial assessment to evaluate their current water polo skills. Based on the results, they will be placed in the appropriate training group. As the camp progresses and players master specific skills, they will advance to more challenging levels to ensure continuous development.

LEVEL 1

MORNING PRACTICE:

- Movement with and without the ball
- Technique
- Shooting
- Duel game (in transition, positional attack – outside positions and center-defender matchup)

EVENING PRACTICE:

- Specific technique and shooting
- Situational shooting in pairs by position
- Situational 3-on-3 play (transition, positional attack, man-up)
- Duel game (by positions)
- Game

LEVEL 2

MORNING PRACTICE:

- Specific passing (to the post, to the center, after driving in)
- Specific shots (underhand shot, over-the-head shot, delayed shot, trick shot, disguised wrist shot)
- Specific duel game by positions
- Situational 3-on-3 play (positional attack, man-up)

EVENING PRACTICE:

- Transition (counterattack, ball movement, quick execution in 2-on-2 and 3-on-3, pressing in transition)
- Man-up
- Man-down
- Game with tactical assignments
- Situational shooting (against 1, 2, or 3 blocks)

RADNIČKI IS A CLUB WITH 12 OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALISTS TRAIN WITH A CLUB OF OLYMPIC CHAMPIONS

Water Polo Club Radnički is a club with 12 Olympic gold medalists — one of the most successful high-performance environments in modern water polo.

The camp is built on Radnički's methodology, philosophy, and winning standards. The same principles that shaped Olympic champions — precision, discipline, tactical intelligence, and individual development — form the core of our program.

From Olympic titles to World and European Championships, Champions League trophies, and domestic dominance, Radnički's players have conquered every major competition. Most remarkably, many have reached the pinnacle of sport multiple times — standing on top of the Olympic podium.

Nikola Jakšić and **Sava Randelović** have each won 3 Olympic gold medals (2016, 2020, 2024). **Andrija Prlainović** and **Duško Pijetlović** (2016, 2020), as well as **Strahinja Rašović** and **Nikola Dedović** (2020, 2024), have each secured 2. Meanwhile, **Viktor Rašović**, **Radoslav Filipović**, **Radomir Drašović** and **Petar Jakšić** claimed gold in Paris 2024. Olympic gold was also won by **Uroš Stevanović** as head coach, along with assistant coaches **Miloš Ostojić** and **Dajana Zoretić**.

At the 2026 European Championship, Radnički was the club with the highest number of gold medalists — 7 players — along with 5 members of staff.

World-Class Training Facilities in Trebinje

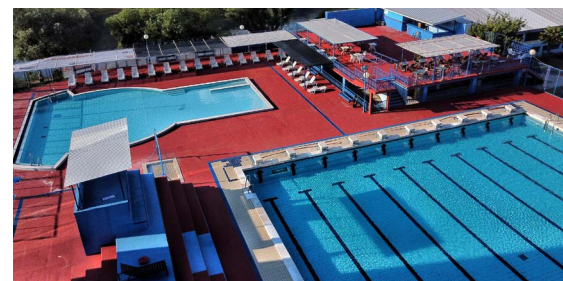
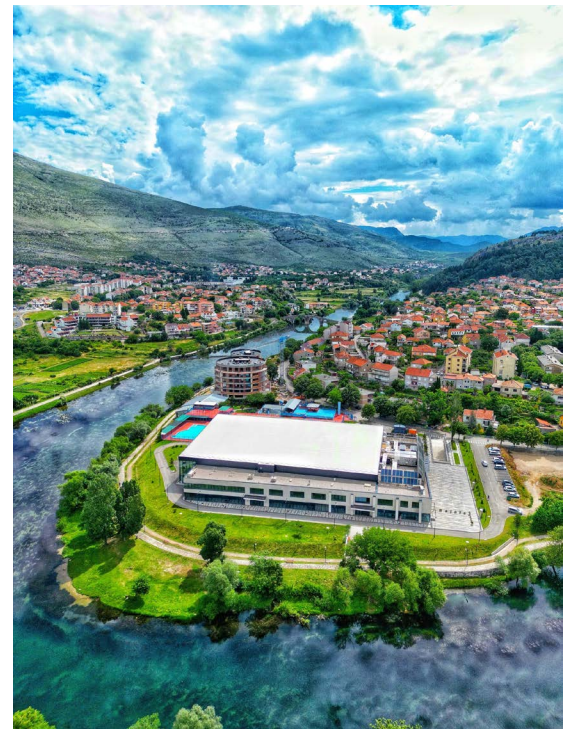
The Summer Water Polo Camp VK Radnički & Andrija Prlainović will take place at the world-class facilities of the modern JU "Bazeni" complex in Trebinje, where participants will train in both indoor and outdoor pools. Camp athletes will be accommodated in a newly opened 4-star hotel located within the complex, set in a beautiful location just a short walk from the city center.

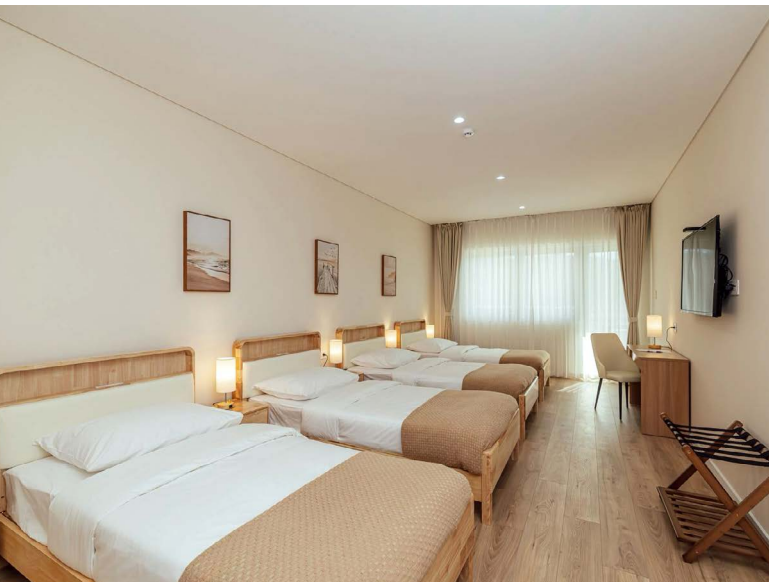
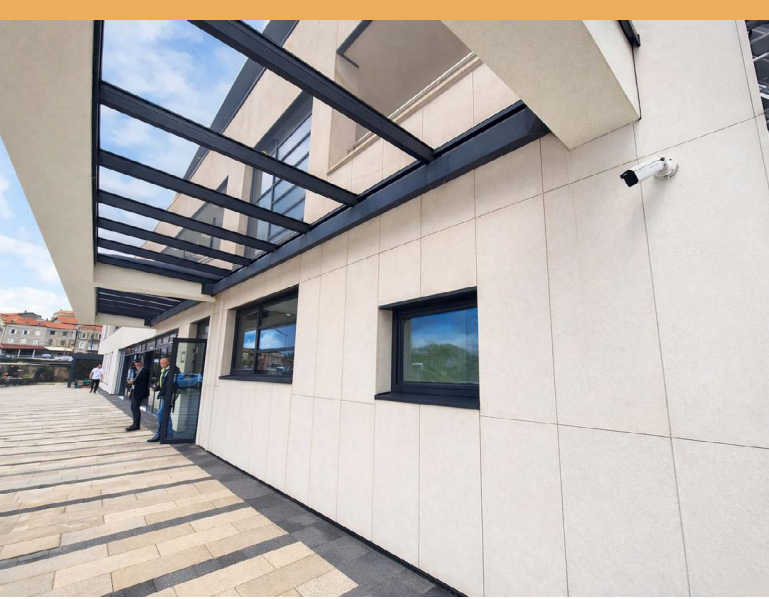
The centerpiece of the venue is the modern indoor Olympic pool "Ana Čučković", completed in 2022, which completes Trebinje's elite sports infrastructure and establishes the city as a rising hub for competitive swimming and water polo — not only locally but throughout Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Built to the highest standards of energy efficiency and fully compliant with World Aquatics regulations, the facility is capable of hosting top-level international competitions. It features:

A competition-ready Olympic indoor pool with the latest digital timing and training technology. Seating for 375 spectators, offering an exciting live atmosphere. Modern locker rooms and athlete support areas designed for elite training

The complex also includes a spacious outdoor Olympic pool, covering approximately 5,000 m² of aquatic space with a water surface of 1,450 m², providing ideal conditions for varied training sessions and tactical development.

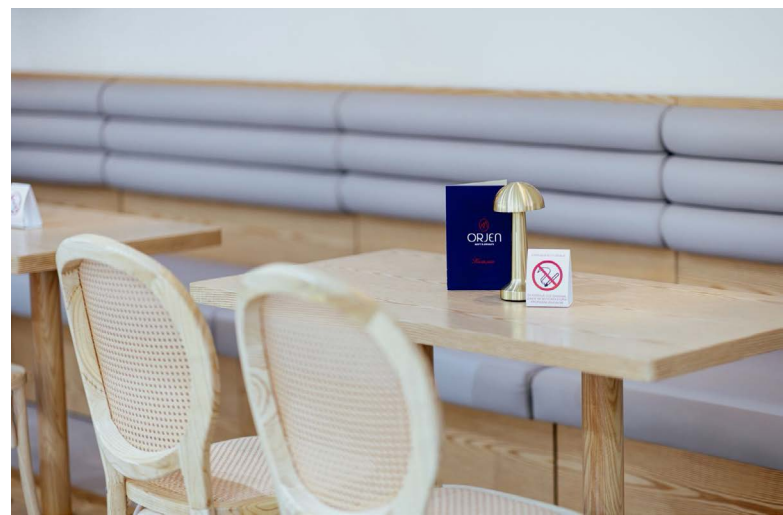
HOTEL ORJEN - 4-star gem within the pool complex

VK RADNIČKI

Rising to the Top of European Water Polo

The Water Polo Club Radnički was founded on April 25, 2012. Displaying remarkable skill and determination, Radnički swiftly rose to the highest level of Serbian competition and the European stage.

Led by a powerhouse lineup featuring Vanja Udovičić, Filip Filipović, Aleksandar Ćirić, Boris Zloković, Damir Burić, and Zdravko Radić, and guided by head coach Dejan Udovičić, the team dominated the 2012/13 season, winning the LEN Euro Cup with a flawless record. Their momentum carried into the following season, where they secured 10 victories in the Champions League and reached the final tournament. In a thrilling final against Barceloneta, they fought valiantly but narrowly missed the title, finishing as European vice-champions with a 7:6 scoreline.



Driven today by sports director Jugoslav Vasović and head coach Uroš Stevanović, who also serves as the head coach of the Serbian national team, KVK Radnički stands as one of Europe's elite teams, competing at the highest level in the Champions League.

Radnički has won the Regional League (Vaterpolo regionalna

liga) twice, Europe's strongest league competition (2021 and 2025), and has also been crowned Serbian champion twice (2021, 2025), while also lifting the Serbian National Cup three times. The club is the current Serbian and Regional League champion, and last season reached the EA Euro Cup final, where they were defeated by Pro Recco.

Water Polo Club Radnički is home to a remarkable roster of current and former Serbian national team players, including Andrija Prlainović, Nikola Jakšić, Duško Pijetlović, Sava Ranđelović, Strahinja Rašović, Nikola Dedović, Viktor Rašović, Radoslav Filipović, Petar Jakšić, and Greek star Angelos Vlachopoulos.



In addition to the success of the senior team, Radnički places special emphasis on youth development. Across all age categories, the club consistently ranks among the top teams in Serbia, while a growing number of young international players choose Radnički's development system to advance their careers under the guidance of experienced professional coaches.



The Summer Water Polo Camp represents an ideal opportunity for players who are not part of the club throughout the season to experience Radnički's training methodology, professional standards, and high-performance environment.

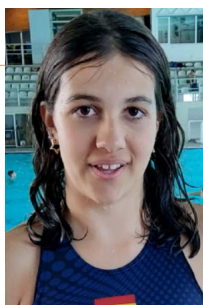
